Special features of Coastal Hospice at the Lake include:

Coastal Hospice at the Lake is designed for times when a short-term inpatient stay is needed for:

- **Pain and Symptom Management**, to assess and treat severe symptoms (such as pain, breathing difficulty or anxiety) that cannot be managed at home.
- **Respite Care** gives caregivers the opportunity to get the rest they need. Most insurance will cover up to five days.
- **Transitional Care** is valuable when a patient is leaving the hospital and needs medication adjustment. Our staff will modify the medication plan and teach family members what they will need to know at home.
