Coastal Hospice at the Lake is a dedicated inpatient hospice facility located in a beautifully renovated wing of historic Deer's Head Hospital Center in Salisbury. This peaceful setting provides three levels of care:

- General Inpatient Care for short-term, intensive symptom management
- Respite Care offering a five-night stay to give caregivers a much-needed break
- Routine Home Care delivered in our hospice inpatient facility setting when appropriate

A general inpatient stay at Coastal Hospice at the Lake is appropriate when symptoms (pain, difficulty breathing, or anxiety/agitation) require focused medical attention that cannot be managed in any other home/residential setting. A hospice physician visits daily, and experienced medical staff are on-site 24 hours a day to ensure comfort, safety, and quality, compassionate care.
